Following the critically acclaimed release of her sophomore solo album, "Onto the Floor", signed major label act Anti-Hero's former frontwoman, **Rose Cora Perry** is back rocking again.

Formed last year, her new project, **The Truth Untold** (featuring Perry on Vocals, Guitar and Songwriting) has already taken Southwestern Ontario by storm, winning over crowds of 25,000+ at notable festivals within a mere six months of forming. Kicking off their international efforts, just last month, The Truth Untold was selected as the **ONLY** Canadian band to showcase at Summer NAMM in Nashville.

In line with the group's current touring efforts, The Truth Untold have been scheduled as special guest performers at this year's **St. Thomas Iron Horse Festival on Friday August 18th at 7:00 pm.**

This year's festival includes: free train rides, a carnival, food vendors, kids activities, live music and a psychic fair. Admission to the festival grounds is free; however, paid admission is required to various festival attractions including main stage concerts and midway rides.
