

Perry To Rock Vans Warped

London-based musician, media personality and model Rose Cora Perry recently informed Scene that her new group, The Truth Untold, will play a big gig in Toronto later this summer. Launched in 2016 by Perry and drummer Tyler Randall — and recently assisted by touring bassist Amber Gorham — the band has been gaining acclaim for its songs and music videos. “I’m beyond thrilled to tell you that my band was hand-selected to perform by the founder himself on the only Canadian date of the very last Vans Warped Tour,” said Perry. The Truth Untold added another prestige show to their resume when the powerhouse trio shared the stage with industry vets Chuck Wright (Quiet Riot), Chris Ralles (Pat Benatar), Mitch Perry (The Sweet) and L7 at the legendary Whisky a Go Go’s Ultimate Jam Night in West Hollywood earlier this year. Founded in 1995 by Kevin Lyman, Vans Warped Tour is the longest running travelling music festival in North American history. The 2018 line-up will showcase up and comers alongside their more established peers. Attendees can expect a solid mix of punk, ska, alternative and hardcore bands with appearances by Sum41, Silverstein, Simple Plan, Underoath, The Used, Less than Jake, and Taking Back Sunday. Rose Cora Perry & The Truth Untold are slated to rock the Full Sail University Stage on Tuesday, July 17 at The Flats at Budweiser Stage (909 Lake Shore Blvd W. Toronto, Ontario). Doors open at 11:00 am.
